



#### "Is my sin more powerful than the blood of Jesus Christ?"

God's Endless Compassion: A Lesson from Paul's Journey

I've met many people who truly believe their past mistakes have made them unworthy of God's love. They often think of themselves as broken, feeling there's no way back to redemption.

To those who feel discouraged, I like to ask, "Have you done anything worse than what Paul did before he found Christ?" Paul himself recognized that he was the worst of sinners, having persecuted and even killed God's followers, thinking he was doing the right thing.

But even in his darkest moments, God showered Paul with His incredible grace. The Lord reached out to him, showing love to someone who had been actively opposing Him. Paul shared that this was to show His limitless patience to everyone.




#### **Did You Know?**







# Some of you will remember the Hope Thanksgiving potlucks of long, long ago. The con-

gregation was mighty big back then, and many people enjoyed the meal. Some people had eyes larger than their stomachs which left others with a mere meal of a chicken wing and a cup of green Jello. But we don't focus on the negative because the positive brings gratitude. One tradition was to celebrate with *Five Kernels of Corn*. This is a tradition coming from the Pilgrim days. Due to epidemic and severe cold, by the end of winter 55 people gathered in view of 40 graves. The ship, which was to bring relief, arrived without provisions, but with 35 more mouths to feed. Tradition held that they were down to a ration of five kernels of corn a day.

In gratitude, remember this tradition: Place five kernels of corn on the Thanksgiving dinner plate and have each person share the many blessings for which they are thankful.
