





HOPE'S MENS GROUP: Our next meeting is on Saturday April 12th, 2025 at 8:00 AM in the Fellowship Hall as well as on Zoom. We will continue our study of the New Testament book of Galatians. You are encouraged to read Chapter 4 as we will continue our line by line study of the book of Galatians. Paul wrote the letter of Galatians to churches he founded in Galatia (modern day Turkey), warning them against certain false teachers. Paul reminds the churches of the simple message of salvation by faith alone, which he and other church leaders teach and concludes with advice on how to live a Spirit-filled life. The words Paul used writing Galatians have very specific meaning and the information in Galatians is foundational to our understanding of Christianity. If you are able to read Galatians in a version different than you normally read, please consider doing so. We will study the meaning and messages in the words Paul wrote in Galatians.



Previous books read by the group are available to borrow! You can find the "library" in the narthex.




Hope Hysterical History

In the early 1980s, Hope was full of hope... but without a home. This nomadic congregation met in various places—rarely the same place for consecutive Sundays. One Sunday our Communion service was under a large oak tree in Glen Oaks Estates. Another Sunday was on the front lawn of the Ellicksons' home in De Luz. The annual picnic was at Lake Skinner one year; at Linfield Christian campus another. A very special Easter service was at our property on Ranch California Road. (There was no Target, no CVS, no Vons, no restaurants. On our property there was no church building! The "little" church was completed many months later.) It was an exceptionally special, sunny Easter Day.




